Barbara J. Zucker received her B.A. from Ursinus College in 1966, studied Fine Art at Arcadia University and at L'Accademia di Belle Arti in Florence, Italy. She apprenticed with painter Richard Callner in his studio after graduating from Tyler School of Art with a M.Ed. in 1971.

She taught painting and drawing at Ursinus College from 1982 to 1999. Later she served as Gallery Director at ViewPoint LLC Arts and Events House and then as coordinator for the Gallery at the Community Music School in Trappe. She is President Emerita of Philadelphia/Tri State Artists Equity, and was Exhibition Chair of that organization for sixteen years. She is also a Signature Member of The Philadelphia Water Color Society. Her work is represented by the Littlefield Gallery in Winter Harbor, Maine,

Barbara's award winning paintings have been exhibited in hundreds of solo, curated and juried exhibits. In 2014, the Berman Museum of Art at Ursinus College honored her with a major 40 year retrospective. Her work is also displayed in numerous public, corporate, and private collections.
