ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Maximum of Entries:

Up to three (3) works may be submitted. More than three (3) may be accepted at the discretion of the Gallery Director. Any or all pieces may be marked NFS (not for sale).

Two-Dimensional Work:

All work must be properly framed and wired. Saw tooth hangers are not acceptable. Exposed glass on "frameless" frames is not acceptable. Gallery wrapped canvas is acceptable without exposed staples. Artwork in excess of 60" in any direction including frame will be subject to Gallery Director approval prior to hanging. Multiple part works are acceptable but those exceeding 60" in any direction including frame will be subject to Gallery Director approval prior to hanging. Note that work of one or more pieces counts as one entry.

Three Dimensional Work:

Work that is not freestanding must be securely attached to a base. Sculpture stands will be provided. Please call or contact the PAAG if you have any questions regarding any different size limitations before you submit your entries.

General requirements:

- Only original artwork will be allowed. Copies or reproductions will NOT be accepted. Art that is a direct copy in its entirety of another artist's work, a direct copy in its entirety of published/printed sources or a direct copy in its entirety of photographs which are not originated by the submitting artist are not eligible.
- All artwork must be for sale or marked NFS (not for sale). No POR (price on request) will be allowed.
 - In the event that any of the Works are purchased or contracted for purchase from the artist by a third party during the period of the show, the artist agrees to donate 20% of profits, from the sale to the "Friends of the Galleries," a non-profit 501c(3) organization that is part of the Montgomery County Community College Foundation. Artists will be notified by e-mail or phone of any interested buyer.
- A completed and signed Montgomery County Community College Art Loan Intake Form must be submitted by November 18, 2022.

NOTE: A completed set of Entry Labels must be submitted with the Intake Form.

The terms and conditions of the loan of any artwork for this show are as noted in the Details and Specifications for the Montgomery County Community College Art Loan Intake Form.

- The Pottstown Area Artists Guild show organizers and Gallery Director reserve the right to reject artwork not meeting all the above requirements or any work they deem unacceptable for this exhibit.
- All artwork must be properly labeled on the back of artwork at time of drop off.
- No art work may be removed during the exhibit, except for a sale as approved by the Gallery Director.
- We would welcome brief (up to 150 words)
 narratives about your particular pieces and how
 they came to be (inspiration, technique, context).
 These narratives will be mounted adjacent to the
 label for the piece. Please include with the Intake
 form.

AWARD:

Guild Members will vote for the \$100 Best in Show Award at the Opening Reception.

ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees are non-refundable

\$10 entry fee for each artist regardless of the number of pieces submitted.

DIRECTIONS:

The entrance to gallery in the Montgomery Community College North Hall is located at 16 East High Street in Pottstown.
