Dane Tilgham “Using paint and pencil I create full color narratives calibrating the common moments of humanity chronicled thru nostalgic black and white photography.” Dane has taken his artwork towards new dimensions going from realism to a stylish combination developing his own interpretations of surrealism and primitive elongation. He has established himself as one of the premier painters of African American Art.

His work has been exhibited at the African American Museum in Philadelphia, and also in one-man shows at Howard University, Widener University, West Chester University, University of Pennsylvania, Penn State and the Butler Institute of Fine Art in Youngstown, Ohio. One of his baseball images has been incorporated into the Baseball Hall of fame Museum in Cooperstown, NY and he has created a mural for the Turner Stadium in Atlanta. <https://www.danetilghmanoriginals.com>

- End of Show Pick-up, May 19, 4-6 PM & May 20, 12:30 to 6:30PM.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS:

2D Works

- All works to be properly framed and wired. No saw tooth hangers.
- Gallery wrapped edges acceptable with finished edges. no staples visible.
- If sides less than 1", work must be framed.
- Size not to exceed 30" any direction due to space limitations of gallery.

3D Works

- Must be free standing.
- Pedestal pieces not to exceed 2'sq. Pedestals will be provided.
- Floor pieces not to exceed 3'sq.

GENERAL SPECIFICATION:

- All works, 2 max, must be original works and not previously submitted to a PAAG juried show.
- Copies/reproductions are not accepted.
- One piece may be NFS.
- All works must have entry labels attached to sides of works and visible. These labels are available on line at <https://paag.info/art-show/>.
- Information on Entry Form is final and may not be changed after April 1st. **Sorry, but NO SUBSTITUTIONS will be accepted at intake.**
- 15% of sale price is a commission to PAAG, plus 15% of sale price is a commission to Schwenkfelder Library and Heritage Center.
- Works may not be removed during run of show.
- Artist is responsible to deliver purchases to the buyer.
- 6% PA Sales Tax will be collected.
- Checks for sales will be mailed after close of show. Artists will be notified of sales. A W-9 will be required for sales of \$600 or more.
- Artists must be at least 18 years of age.
- The utmost care will be taken in the handling of the art. Neither Schwenkfelder Library and Heritage Center nor PAAG assumes the responsibility for theft or damage to art work.
- The show committee reserves the rights to reject artwork not meeting all the requirements or works deemed unacceptable to display by the Guild or Schwenkfelder Library and Heritage Center.
